## A VIEW FROM THE VICARAGE

#### THE REVD ANDY BAWTREE

There is much in life which is competitive, we have had the Euros this summer, and the Olympic Games. I am a big England and Team GB fan, whatever sport really, although I tend to enjoy rugby, cricket and football the most – sometimes we win and sometimes we don't; that's a good life lesson. There have been elections with winners and losers, and winning brings new challenges.

Sometimes you might find yourself competing with somebody else for a job or the affection of a sweetheart. It doesn't always feel comfortable when we don't win. In life we do not all win prizes nor collect the cup at the end of the tournament. There are too many variables in the game of life, equality of opportunity is a myth as is the myth of opportunity of outcome - being English is different from being Madagascan, geography and history really matter and in the end the result is the same. We all have a limited lifespan but how we live before we die and what we do with it is dependent on various factors.

However, there is one thing we can all which do which is to consider the invitation that Almighty God offers to everyone equally, because he loves us all equally. Remarkably it doesn't depend on place of birth, school, qualifications, or any other deciding factor; it is freely offered to every living person, every man or woman, boy or girl. It isn't something we can win individually or in a team, through training or hard work, it isn't earned, it is a gift. It is totally inclusive yet remarkably exclusive. God's invitation and offer are available because of Jesus of Nazareth, often called the Christ (the Greek word for Messiah or Anointed One) who makes known the invisible God to us and who looks at the evil and wickedness in the world and the broken imperfect hearts we have and says, "I can sort that out". Hunger isn't just addressed with food banks and food pantries, as much as we seem to need them in our wider community here, it is a matter of the heart. We don't, as a rule, love our neighbour as ourselves as well as we ought, nor love God particularly well either, but the command still stands, as does the promise of a new heaven and new earth one day. Not a synthetic utopia but something even more glorious. Until that day I'll try to compete in the game of life, and I'll cheer England on, whoever they are playing.

## RIVER THEN AND NOW

SUE NICHOLAS

I moved to River in January 1971, to join my late husband Paul who was working for Seaspeed. He was in lodgings until I was able to join him with our children aged six years and eight months, and five years. Our daughter was met by Mrs Headon and two little girls when she started at River school. The greeting was "We have been expecting you Janet". My daughter has always been called by her second name Louise.

We lived with a lovely couple who welcomed us until our new house was ready for completion. Ironically the man who took us in was with my husband two days before he died.

Moving to Kent, having lived in Slough then Chelmsford in Essex, was a new experience for us, seeing hills and valleys. We found everything in the small shops located in River. The Post office, Hairdresser, Hardware shop, Butchers, Greengrocers, Sweet Shop, Benstead's Newsagent, the hardware shop on Lower Road, and Dunfords Nursery to name but a few. There was also a wool shop called Waterfall Stores that my mother liked.

River church was small and compact with pews, and the entrance to the Christian centre was the old main entrance. There was a green tin hut where Abbey Falls is now, which was the church hall where my daughter went to ballet classes. The bus terminus was served by a double decker bus at that time. We had the Dublin Man O' War pub in those days as well as the Oak and the Cricketers. Most of the new build housing has been in fill, Cowper Road for example has doubled in size as houses were built in the then very long gardens.

The River Parish Council came many years later and in 1987 I was one of the Councillors elected. We also enjoyed our River Carnival, and the Dover Carnival started from Lewisham Road.

Cricket was played on the recreation ground. Many areas have changed over the years. The Bowls club has been rebuilt. Donkeys were to be found in River Meadow. Freddy Mack was the greengrocer who delivered fruit and veg around the village in a green van. River Meadow, Dourside and Mannering Close all now have houses on where the greengrocer, meadows and fields were previously. Dunfords had a shop backing onto Lewisham Road where the self-build houses are now.

I may have missed a few things off over the last 54 years living in the villages. I am now 86, so I hope you get a flavour of the changes.

The committee and bakers supported President Pat for her annual Meningitis Coffee Morning held by kind permission of River Methodist Church.

Our quiz night on 15 June was over-subscribed and, following a fun evening, we decided to hold quizzes more often as people seem to like them. Next one is Saturday 23 November 7.30pm. Our River WI quiz team retained the Group Quiz trophy for another year

We had a really good meeting in July with entertaining speaker, Frances Smith, talking about her adventures trekking in Mongolia. Fermented mares' milk and mutton for every dinner, camel and pony treks, amazing scenery and lovely people were involved, but descriptions and photos of sanitary arrangements made us all think maybe a staycation would be preferable! Great presenter and intrepid lady.

We also had Penny Bailey from St Margaret's WI talking about the Annual Meeting at the Albert Hall where a lot of the content was about violence against women, which is a huge concern at the moment. The National Police Chief's Council reported in July that violence against women and girls is now a national emergency that 'poses as much of a threat to society as terrorism'. Stalking, sexual assault, harassment and domestic violence affect one in twelve women in England and Wales. 3,000 crimes reported a day; two million victims a year! One of the speakers was Melanie Brown M.B.E (Scary Spice) who escaped from an abusive marriage and now campaigns to help women in difficulties.

A treat on 19 September: Pete Allen who has been an actor, theatre director, film maker, and community arts organiser will be presenting an illustrated talk about detectives on TV. He is an excellent speaker and most interesting. Again, visitors are welcome. More treats (we hope!) on 17 October when Jane Napper will be demonstrating chocolate swirls. Oh yes!! We made sure that we didn't ask Jane in the summer in case the swirls melted before we could get at them!

## THE RIVER KITCHEN

#### REBECCA WHALLEY

Hello, everyone, and welcome to my recipe column! I'm Rebecca, an aspiring food writer and journalist. Although my roots are in Dover, I've been lucky to travel and indulge in foods and flavours from across the world. I'm a very passionate foodie, and I've garnered a lot of cooking experience, from taking soba noodle making classes in central Japan, to learning how to fillet fish in a cookery school in rural Devon. I hope I can pass on some of knowledge that people have been kind enough to pass on to me.

However, I thought I'd start with something simple for my first recipe — an easy, yet delicious, chocolate cake. We all know that homemade tastes better, and many would agree that not much tastes better than a good chocolate cake. Someone gave this recipe to my mum about 20 years ago, and it's been our family's go-to ever since for a reason. The recipe is, honestly, fool proof - I've been making this since I was around 8 years old, and I was no Michelin starworthy chef, but every time I'm surprised by how rich and moist the sponge is. This recipe basically involves throwing a selection of cost-effective ingredients together and putting it in the oven, but I have to say I've never had a homemade cake better than this one.

Classic chocolate cake with buttercream icing

I cup of cocoa powder

2 cups of flour

2 cups of sugar

2 eggs

10 grams vanilla essence

I cup of cooking oil

I cup of milk

I tsp of bicarbonate of soda

2 tsp of baking powder

I cup of hot boiled water

Combine all ingredients together and pour into a medium sized, round cake tin. Bake for 45 minutes – I hour at 180°.
