

We will as normal erect the village Christmas tree in early December.


PARISH MEETINGS

TAKE A RISK -CELEBRATE CHRISTMAS!

Christmas is a risky business Dhopefully fun, certainly busy Dbut risky!

As I write the churches are already busy preparing for the special services for Advent and Christmas $\mathbf D$ getting ready to hear the story of Christmas once more. So $\acute{\mathbf E}$ are you sitting comfortably $\acute{\mathbf E}$? Well, perhaps we shouldn $\acute{\mathbf D}$ be $\acute{\mathbf D}$ because if we $\acute{\mathbf Q}$ getting ready for a cosy, comfortable story about a baby in a manger then I think we $\acute{\mathbf Q}$ missed the point!

Think about the characters in the story $\acute{\bf E}$ Mary, Jesus $\~{\bf O}$ nother, was sitting very comfortably, her life ahead was planned and predictable as the future wife of a $\~{\bf O}$ arpenter $\~{\bf O}$ - but God $\~{\bf O}$ request through the angel who visited her, soon changed all that. From the moment of her $\~{\bf O}$ es $\~{\bf O}$ 0 that request, Mary $\~{\bf O}$ 1 life took an extremely risky turn because now she faced, what would most likely be at that time, over 2000 years ago, a complete rejection by her fianc $\breve{\bf Z}$ her family and her community. Joseph too, was sitting comfortably. He was to be married, to have a family - life for him would take its proper course \acute{E} but God had other plans for him. Joseph was to take on a woman already pregnant, which in those days meant risking the scorn and mockery of his friends and family \acute{E} and he was to take the risk of caring for the one who was to become the Saviour of the world.

The shepherds and wise men, visitors who went to see the child Jesus, were sitting comfortably in their own ways \mathbf{D} they knew what they were about. Their roles, although very different(!), were comfortably secure $\dot{\mathbf{E}}$ and then they were shaken up and challenged \mathbf{D} and sent on a journey of discovery to find the Christ-child. The shepherds risked rejection and abuse from a town which

would have been hostile to their presence there and the wise men risked a long desert journey to an unknown destination in foreign territory.

This is no comfortable story! For God has taken the ultimate risk of sending his Son into the world and revealing the full extent of his love for us.

We can sit comfortably and just enjoy the trappings of Christmas \mathbf{D} or we can take the risk, just as the characters in our story did, of allowing $\mathsf{God}\tilde{\mathbf{O}}$ message of love to shake us up and challenge us to look at life in new ways. The characters in our story were never alone on their journey and neither are we; we too can put our hand in the hand of God who shows his love to us in Jesus who was also called Immanuel, which means $\hat{\mathbf{O}}$ od is with us $\hat{\mathbf{O}}\mathsf{God}\hat{\mathbf{O}}$ love with us, for us, for ever $\hat{\mathbf{D}}$ so go on, take the risk and celebrate Christmas!

I wish you, on behalf of the churches in River, a very happy Christmas and a peaceful New Year.

RIVER THEN AND NOW

The village school had an intake of approximately 200 pupils. Some of the children had to walk back and forth to the village hall, mostly for their morning lessons as the old buildings could not accommodate all of the pupils.

The school kitchen was in the playground. This was later demolished and children were educated on site, albeit in mobiles in the playground, which meant less room to play. These were cold in the winter and hot in the summer, some pupils crawled under them!

I spent a lot of time going to and from the education office situated in Dover and then journeys to Folkestone where I hammered home that we needed new classrooms.

I recall bursting into a meeting that was about to close, as I had been to a meeting at DDC. I can still see the look on their faces; they said \grave{O} oh no! Not her \acute{O} I demanded that the area for teaching our children should be significantly improved. Now we have an extension built and better facilities.

The school now has an intake of over 400 pupils with modern facilities. Rome was not built in a day, however, never one to give up, I banged desks. It was suggested I become a governor. I became a governor eventually but not for River school. I became one at St Radigunds, where I spent IO happy years.

THE FESTIVE RIVER KITCHEN

REBECCA WHALLEY

There is no Christmas treat I love more than Stollen. Originating from Germany, Stollen is a fruit-filled sweet bread flavoured with spices and almonds. Making Stollen isn $\tilde{\mathbf{O}}$ the fastest process in the world, but it $\tilde{\mathbf{O}}$ sure worth the effort.

Now, some people are averse to marzipan - bizarre, I know - so feel free to leave it out if it doesn't suit your tastes.

Christmas Stollen Recipe

180ml apple juice 30g blanched whole almonds

7g dried yeast 10g butter, melted

250g plain flour, plus a little extra for 75g cold marzipan, cut into small

dusting pieces

Generous pinch of ground cinnamon Generous pinch of ground aniseed or

allspice

Small pinch of ground cloves

- 1. Soak the dried fruit in 100ml of boiled water. Warm through the apple juice in a pan and then add the yeast to it. Leave the yeast to activate for 10-15 minutes, during which it will start to bubble.
- 2. Put the flour into a bowl. Stir in the yeast and juice mixture to form a dough. Cover and leave to prove somewhere warm until roughly

- doubled in size, around 1-2 hours. If you prefer you can put the dough in the fridge to rise slowly overnight.
- 3. Drain the fruit and add it to the dough, alongside the marzipan, nuts and spices. Knead everything together and then put the dough on a lightly-floured work surface. Knead until the fruit stays in the dough.
- 4. Shape the dough into a sausage and place on a baking tray lined with baking paper. Cover it with a clean tea towel and leave it to prove somewhere warm for 30 minutes to 1 hour, until it has risen by about a quarter.
- 5. Remove the stollen from the oven and brush it with melted butter. Dust it with icing sugar. Leave it to cool before slicing it.

Stollen tends to keep for quite a while, usually just under 2 weeks.


